If you rent, own or manage apartments within the City of Sydney* you can register to receive a free assessment and recommendations for electric vehicle charging in your building.

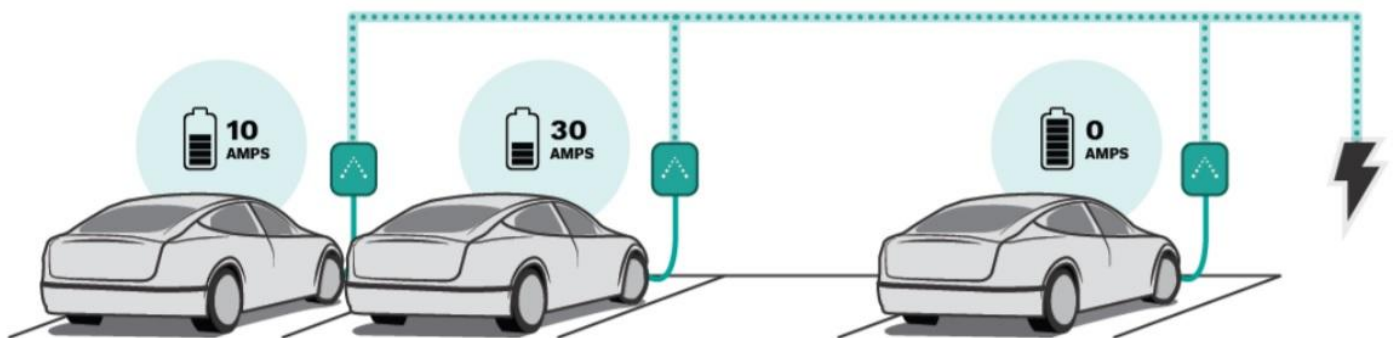
You will receive:
